20 member organisations from 17 countries. Observers 7: European Commission, ERC, EUA, LERU, ALLEA, Vitae



## **MO FORUM SiS – ERA Consultation**

- ScienceEurope has established a working group on the "EU Framework Directive Public Consultation" providing recommendations for the Horizon2020 the EU.
- It is chaired by Franci Demsar, Director of the Slovenian research agency, and is asking for contributions from the MO Forum on the Science in Society relationship issue.
- I. Cameron as Chair of the Forum has been asked to prepare a draft in end October 2011.
