General Aims and Objectives of the Forum

Aims

- To improve evaluation studies on funding schemes
- To learn about best practices of impact assessment of research and research funding
- To identify the challenges in conducting transnational comparative evaluation

Objectives

- To facilitate networking
- To exchange and share information on evaluation studies of funding schemes and practices
- To produce an inventory of current and past impact evaluation practices/methodologies across Member Organisations, identifying gaps and lessons learned
- To develop an analysis of research portfolios and research output

Fields of activities of the Working Groups

WG 1. Evaluation Guidelines

- Draw up guidelines for ex-post evaluation of funding schemes
- Do a survey among the members on evaluation organisation and practices
- Develop a website repository containing evaluation reports and guidelines

▶ WG 2. Impact assessment on Science and Society

- Inform about existing impact studies
- Produce a template for categorising the impact studies
- Conduct an in-depth analysis of impact assessment practices (methodology, criteria, best practice)
- WG 3. Classification systems and Categorisation of output data
 - Examine feasibility of common systems to classify research portfolios
 - Produce a short paper summarising approaches for the analysis of output data



Expected Outcome

► WG 1:

- Website repository of evaluation studies
- Recommendations on Ex-post Evaluations
- Report with Results of Mapping Exercise on evaluation practices/the evaluation function within the Member Organisations

WG 2:

• report with in depth-analysis of practices of impact assessment

WG 3:

- short paper on the classification of research portfolios
- short paper summarising approaches for the analysis of output data
- recommended approaches, "core" set of outputs + guidance on definitions
- potential for pilot exercise

Activities of the Working Groups since last meeting

► WG 1:

- Email feedback on draft of "Evaluation Standards and Good Practices"
- Survey about Evaluation Practices among MOs
- First ideas on Web-based depositories

▶ WG 2:

- Collection of relevant Impact Studies
- First ideas on how to structure/analyse impact studies

▶ WG 3:

- Meeting on classification of research portfolios and collection of output data (December 2010)
- Survey on approaches used to collect output data among MOs and others
- Finalised two reports summarising discussions so far on; i) classification of research portfolios
 ii) collection of output data
- input into the EMRC special policy briefing on research classification approaches
- Discussion of Pilot Studies



Timeline of future activities

Third Meeting in Paris in May 2011:

- work on the material (e.g. surveys)
- develop ideas on the reports
 - summer: further work on the material and drafting of reports

► Fourth Meeting in Fall 2011:

- discussion of drafts of the WGs,
- ideas on dissemination of Forum activities and outputs,
- ideas about the future of the Forum
 - winter: revision of the draft reports

► Fifth Meeting in Spring 2012:

- discussion of final report(s) with the whole Forum
- implementation of marketing/dissemination activities
