## **FP7 Snapshots: Absolute Figures**

#### **Absolute figures (2007 - 2010):**

59.100 proposals

312.600 applicants

12.400 proposals retained

69.300 participants

20,4 billion € EU contribution

169 countries involved





#### **FP7 Snapshots: Participants**

Participants in retained proposals 2010 (% of EU contribution):

- Universities 27%
- "Industry" 26%
- Research Organisations 23%

16,6 % of all participants 2007-2010 are SMEs

#### **FP7 Snapshots: Last Calls**

- 2013 will be the last year for FP7
- Calls covering the Work Programme 2013 will be launched in July 2012
- "Biggest calls ever"
- Bridging to Horizon 2020
   (Innovation, Prizes, ...)





#### **FP7 Ex-Post Evaluation - Basics**

- Foreseen in 2015, two years after the end of FP7
- Expert Panel to provide comprehensive assessment
- Wide range of thematic evaluation studies envisaged
- Horizontal issues to be addressed in specific evaluation studies





## **FP7 Ex-Post Evaluation – Preparation**

- Conceptionalizing of thematic studies on
  - ✓ FP and Human research capacity
  - ✓ FP and major innovations
  - ✓ Research Management Performance
  - ✓ Network Analysis of FP7
- Any advice / reference most welcome
- Open call for tenders to be launched soon





#### **Horizon 2020 - Basics**

- A single programme bringing together three separate programmes/initiatives (FP/CIP/EIT)
- Coupling research to innovation from research to retail, all forms of innovation
- Focus on societal challenges facing EU society,
   e.g. health, clean energy and transport
- **Simplified access**, for all companies, universities, institutes in all EU countries and beyond



## **Horizon 2020 - Simplification**

- Single set of simpler and more coherent participation rules
- New balance between trust and control
- Moving from several funding rates for different beneficiaries and activities to just two
- Replacing the four methods to calculate overhead or «indirect costs» with a single flat rate
- Major simplification under the forthcoming financial regulation
- Successful applicants to get working more quickly: reduction of average time to grant by 100 days (current average of around 350 days under FP7)





#### Horizon 2020 - European Research Area

- ERA framework proposal in 2012 to create a single market for knowledge research and innovation
- Complemented by Horizon 2020:
  - ✓ Boosting support to ERA priorities mobility, infrastructures, knowledge transfer, policy learning
  - ✓ Stronger partnerships with Member States and private sector to invest more efficiently
  - ✓ Taking account of gender, ethical issues, researcher careers and open access to results





## **Horizon 2020 - Partnering**

#### Public private partnerships:

- Joint Technology Initiatives or other formal structures (Art. 187)
- Contractual agreements, which provide inputs for work programmes

#### Public public partnerships:

- "ERA-Nets" for topping up individual calls/actions (replacing current ERA-Net, ERA-Net Plus, Inco-Net, Inno-net)
- Participation in joint programmes between MS (Art. 185)
- Supporting agendas of Joint Programming Initiatives when in line with Horizon 2020

#### **European Innovation Partnerships:**

Not funding instruments, but for coordination with broader policies and programmes



## Horizon 2020 - Widening participation

Horizon 2020 based on principle of excellence - allocate funding on the basis of competitive calls, selecting only the best projects

Division of labour between cohesion policy and Horizon 2020.

- Cohesion policy: support for regions in building up their research and innovation capacity.
- Horizon 2020: widen participation, better coordination between the two Union funding programmes, support policy learning reforms.

**Specific measures in Horizon 2020** to ensure that excellence prevails wherever it exists (Twinning, ERA chairs, support for access to international networks, development of smart specialisation strategies...)

basis of the Commission proposals

**On-going:** Parliament and Council negotiations on EU

budget 2014-2020 (including overall budget

for Horizon 2020)

**Mid 2012:** Final calls under FP7 to bridge gap towards

Horizon 2020

**Mid 2013:** Adoption of legislative acts by Parliament

and Council on Horizon 2020

1/1/2014: Horizon 2020 starts, launch of first calls
