Reliable linking of researchers and their research is impossible without unique identifiers for both

The scholarly record is broken

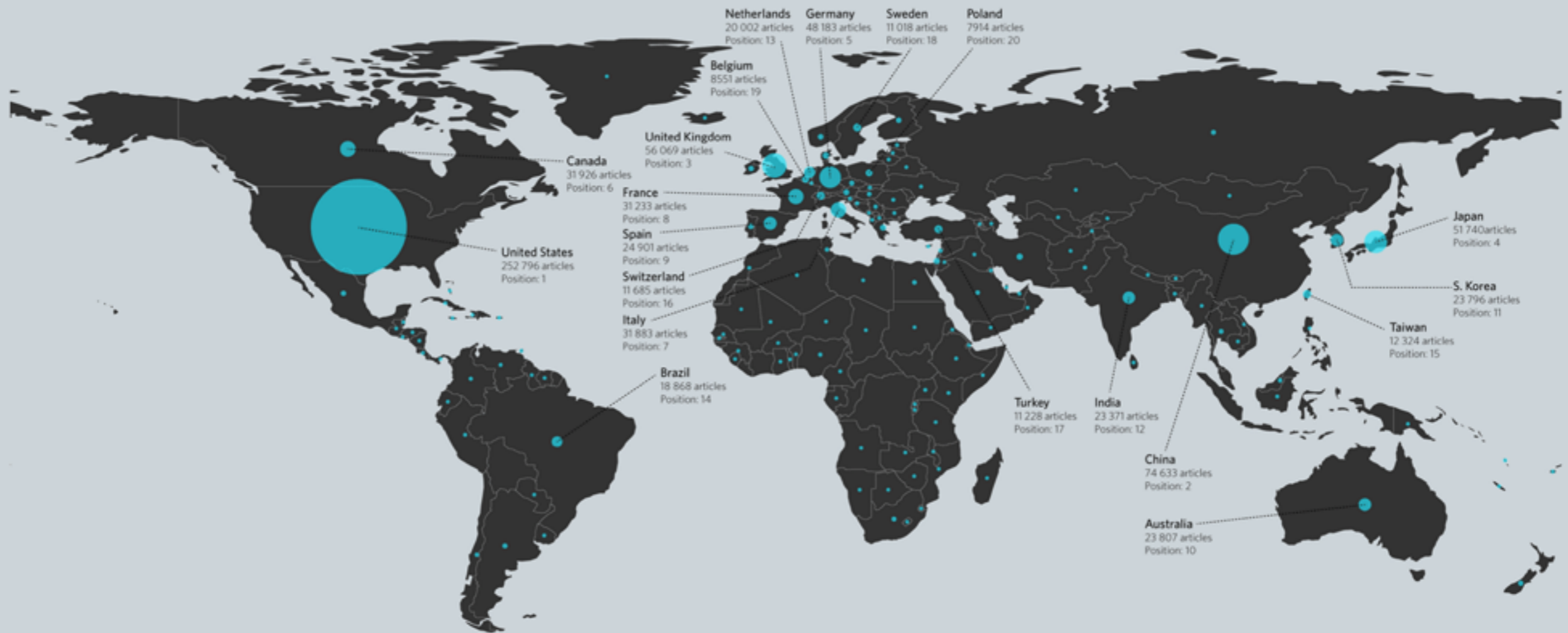

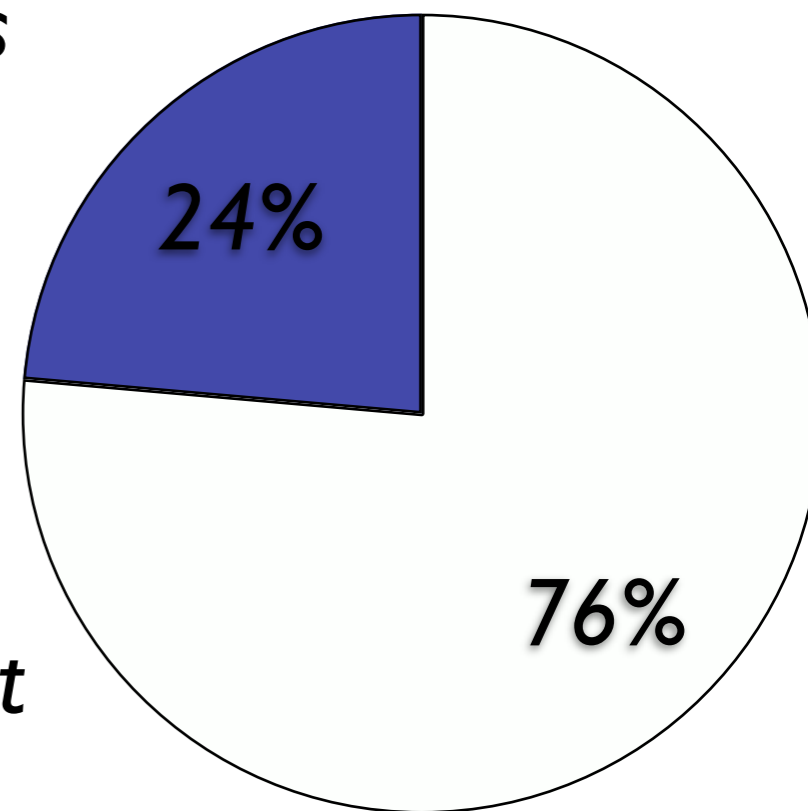

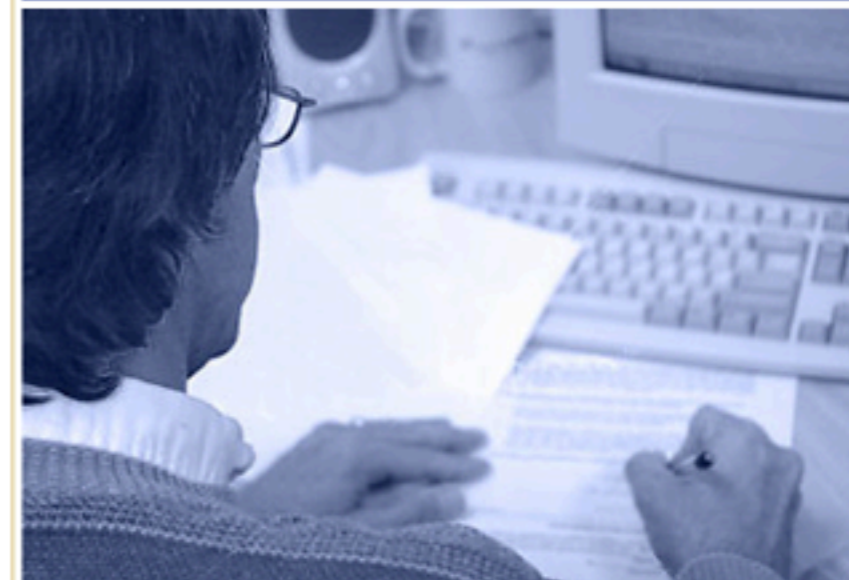
