
Briefly about ESF



- 75 **Member Organisations** (30 countries)
 - Research funding organisations
 - Research performing organisations
 - Learned Societies
- **Budget**: about € 40 million in 2006, including à la carte activities and external contracts.

Developed in response to clearly expressed needs from MOs in the consultations on the strategic plan, MO FORA are


"output-oriented, issue-related venues for MOs, involving others as appropriate, to (exchange information and experiences) and develop joint actions".





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Starting Point

- Go beyond exchange of experience and programme administration
- Address pressing issues, e.g.
 - ⇒ Access to full potential of human resources for RTD (all socio-economic backgrounds)
 - ⇒ Retainment of researchers
 - ⇒ Career development structures
 - ⇒ Intersectoral, international, interdisciplinary, interprofessional mobility
 - ⇒ Demand of the knowledge-based economy





The Aims

Vision

Creation of a think tank for advice on research career policies

Primary goals

- Policy recommendations to member organisations on the basis of surveys and analyses
- Mutual learning of MOs ⇒ programme development and inspiration to new programmes
- Provision of an interface between the national and the supranational level (EU, ERC etc.)
- Contribution to global visibility of the ERA as RTD labour market


