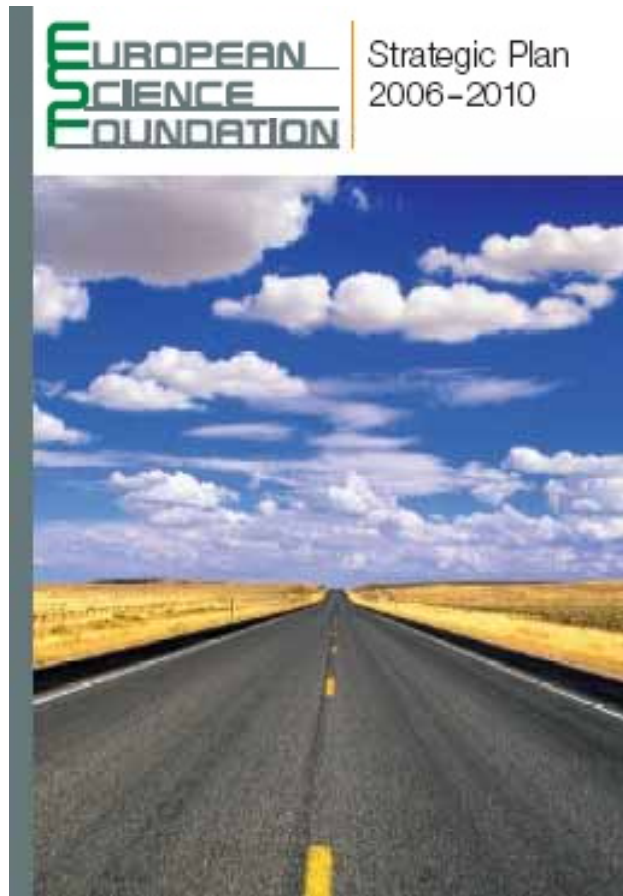

Briefly about ESF



- **75 Member Organisations** (30 countries)
 - Research funding organisations
 - Research performing organisations
 - Learned Societies

- **Budget:** about € 40 million in 2006, including à la carte activities and external contracts.



Developed in response to clearly expressed needs from MOs in the consultations on the strategic plan, MO FORA are

“output-oriented, issue-related venues for MOs, involving others as appropriate, to (exchange information and experiences) and develop joint actions”.

“ESF aims to be the actor of choice and preferred partner when national research organisations develop joint activities.”

Starting Point

- Go beyond exchange of experience and programme administration
- Address pressing issues, e.g.
 - ⇒ Access to full potential of human resources for RTD (all socio-economic backgrounds)
 - ⇒ Retainment of researchers
 - ⇒ Career development structures
 - ⇒ Intersectoral, international, interdisciplinary, inter-professional mobility
 - ⇒ Demand of the knowledge-based economy

Vision

- Creation of a think tank for advice on research career policies

Primary goals

- Policy recommendations to member organisations on the basis of surveys and analyses
- Mutual learning of MOs ⇒ programme development and inspiration to new programmes
- Provision of an interface between the national and the supranational level (EU, ERC etc.)
- Contribution to global visibility of the ERA as RTD labour market

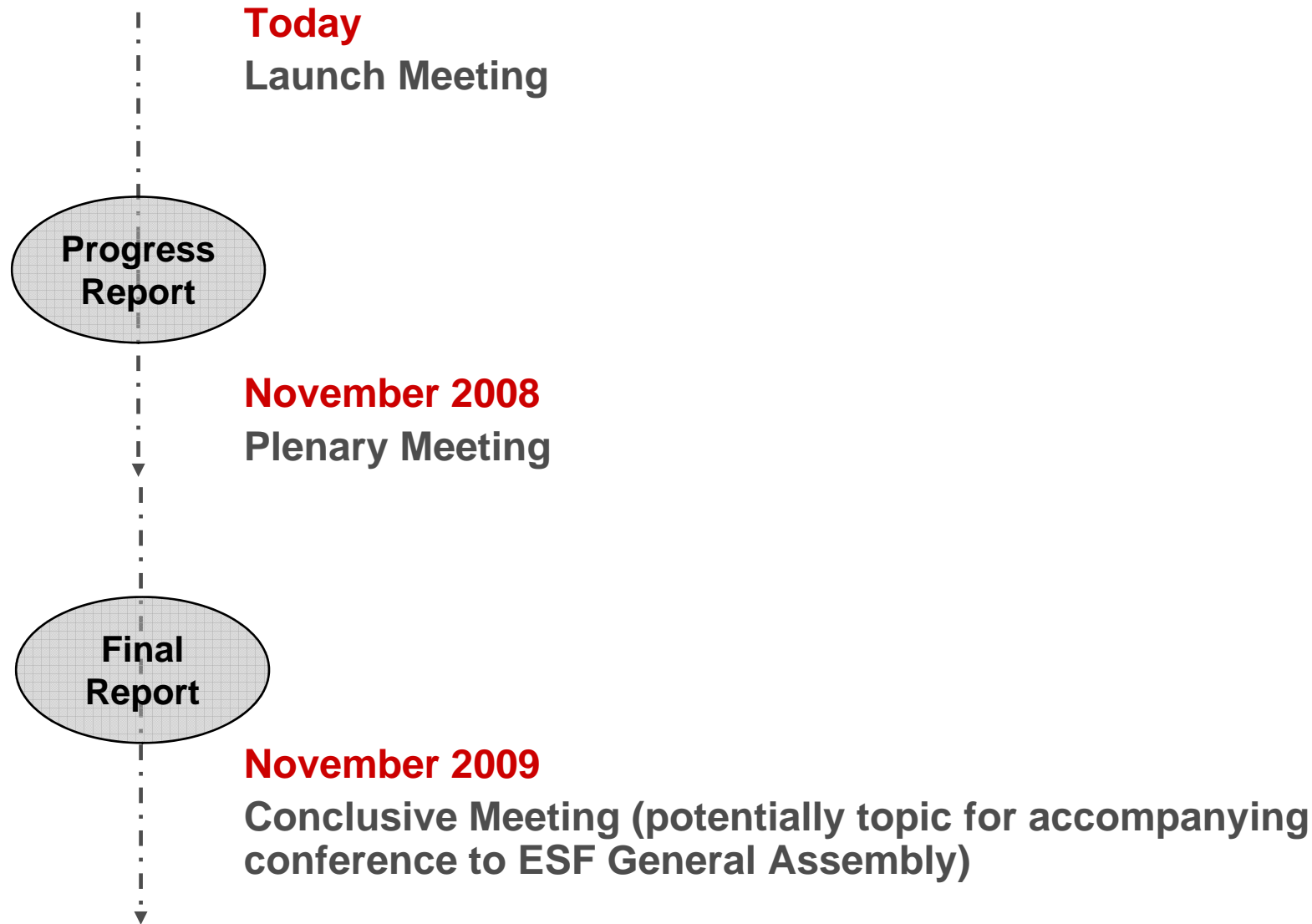
What would we like to have achieved at the end of the day?
