Governing Board decision 4 October 2012

- To set up a Science Europe working group on Research Infrastructures in 2013;
 - Ensuring continuity of work carried out by ESF MO Fora on Research Infrastructures, while adapting mandate to Science Europe structure and focus.



Mandate

- To advise Science Europe members on all Research Infrastructures related matters;
 - Including but not limited to MERIL.
- To make recommendations for the implementation of the relevant Roadmap Action.
 - Including support to Roadmap revision process.



Activities

- Concrete activities will be discussed and agreed by the Working Group members at a kick-off meeting. Possible activities could include:
 - Promote alignment between the various bodies and initiatives in the RI area (and contribute from SE's perspective);
 - Engagement with MERIL;
 - Provide input for SE's engagement with ESFRI;
 - Establish links to scientific communities (via SE Scientific Comms.);
 - Community-specific actions;
 - Networks of RIs;
 - Management of RIs;
 - Transfer of best practice;
 - Exchange of staff;
 - Bilateral investments;



Guidelines

- Open to all Science Europe Member Organisations
- Chair may invite external experts on ad hoc basis
- Duration of 2-3 years (extendable)
- Interim reports to Governing Board and General Assembly
- Meeting of WG chairs and Scientific Committees Chairs



Kick-off meeting

- In early 2013, to:
 - Define Terms of Reference;
 - Define mandate;
 - Discuss workplan (incl. support needed);
 - Discuss input to Roadmap revision process.
