# FL Proposal – The Future of Science in Society

#### Steps

- A Scoping Workshop took place on January 2011 in Strasbourg
- First draft of the proposal was circulated to all participants in the scoping workshop for comments at the end of February
- Second draft of the proposal was circulated to Science, Technology and Society experts for final comments on scientific content in early April
- Final draft of the proposal has been circulated to all the Standing Committees for support in early May
- Final draft of the proposal has been circulated to the MO Forum on Science and Society Relationships for information in early May
- Final version of the proposal to be submitted to the Scientific Advisory Board (SAB) on May 23<sup>rd</sup>
- If recommended by the SAB, then the proposal will be approved at the Governing Council on June 22-23
- The FL then will be launched in September 2011
