

MO FORUM SiS – ERA Consultation

- ScienceEurope has established a working group on the "EU Framework Directive Public Consultation" providing recommendations for the Horizon2020 the EU.
- It is chaired by Franci Demsar, Director of the Slovenian research agency, and is asking for contributions from the MO Forum on the Science in Society relationship issue.
- JP Alix as Chair of the Forum has prepared a draft in October 2011.
- Other "Roadmap" groups requested contribution:
 - ESF MO Forum SiS
 - ESF MO Forum Careers
 - ESF MO Forum Research Infrastructures
 - EH WG Cross-border Research Collaboration
 - EH WG Wider International Cooperation
- Final document to be issue January/February 2012



MO FORUM SiS Next Steps - Timeline

December 2009 – December 2012

However:

- ESF Governing Council September 2011 decided to allocate budget to this Forum only until <u>July 2012</u>
 - The approved budget includes: Workshop May 2012; ESOF session; Report Layout
- ESF Governing Council requested ESF leadership to inform ScienceEurope on this Forum to be consider for their future activites



Forward Look Proposal – The Future of Science in Society

- A Scoping Workshop took place on January 2011 in Strasbourg
- First draft of the proposal by end of February
- Second draft of the proposal by early April
- Final version of the proposal to be submitted to the Scientific Advisory Board (SAB) on May 23rd >> approved
- Proposal summited for approval to the ESF Governing Council on June 22-23 >> approved
- Budget of the Forward Look summitted for approval to the ESF Governing
 Council on 29 September>> not started as a result of budget reductions
- Attempt proposal for a <u>Science Policy Briefing</u> (published by mid-2012) >> decision end-November 2011



Structure of the Forum Workshop

Objectives of the meeting:

- 1. To discuss the chapters of the Forum's recommendations report
- 2. To work further on the draft of the Forum's recommendations report
- 3. To agree on the contents of the report
- 4. To agree on the process of consultation with MOs top managers on regards of the Forum's recommendations
- 5. To agree on a timeline/action plan to deliver the report by July 2012
