**12th Annual Symposium of the
European LeukemiaNet**

Mannheim February 2-4, 2015

Coordinator: Prof. Dr. Rüdiger Hehlmann

Summary

The European LeukemiaNet is an EU - initiated research network of excellence with the aims to integrate leukemia research across Europe, to improve the management of leukemia, spread excellence globally and expand knowledge.

The 12th Annual Symposium of the European LeukemiaNet (ELN) was held on February 2 to 4, 2015 in Mannheim, Germany. The ELN Network management center (NMC) organized the scientific programme and provided the operational and organizational infrastructure of the symposium and workpackage (WP) meetings. This includes the scientific program, meeting facilities, catering, accommodations and reimbursement of travel costs. It was a major goal and challenge to get the members of all ELN workpackages face-to-face together. In total, more than 460 participants from 37 countries attended the Symposium including three invited keynote speakers from China and the USA. The programme was available for download on the ELN homepage. Traditionally this event is combined with the Annual Symposium of the German Competence Network on Leukemia (KNL), which directly follows the ELN Symposium and in 2015 already took place for the 16th time.

The 12th Annual Symposium of the European LeukemiaNet was supported with grants from the European Science Foundation, the ELN-Foundation and synergies with KNL. The ELN is grateful for the support.

Scientific content of and discussion at the Symposium

On the first day (**2.2.2015**) a workshop was presented: Understanding modern statistical methods applied to clinical trials in Leukemia.



The joint **ELN/ESF-ELN Steering Committee Meeting (17:30-19:00)** followed in the late afternoon on the first day (by invitation only, separate protocol).

On the second day (**3.2.2015**), all ELN-Workpackages had their meetings. Challenges and new directions in leukemia and related disease entities were highlighted during the workpackage meeting in three consecutive sessions. Each WP reported on the different projects and discussed future objectives of the group for the coming year.

Session I (11:45 – 13:45) WP4, WP7, WP8

WP4 The progresses of the EURO-SKI study and the EUTOS registry were presented. The Russian and Italian registries of pregnancies during CML compared their current results, and the implication of these was discussed with the auditorium. The application for HORIZON2020 was scheduled for 2016, and it was decided to use the EUTOS data within the application for a grant. A prospective study on metabolic side effects of TKIs was introduced. The session closed with the reports of the ELN Statistical Committee and the Committee on adverse events.

WP7 (chronic lymphocytic leukemia (CLL/ ERIC)) reported on their activities during 2014 (MRD and NGS, a phase II trial on SCT in high risk CLL, the accreditation of Ig sequence analysis and the gene mutations project). There was a presentation of a potential future TP53 Network.

WP8 (myelodysplastic syndromes (MDS)) reported on the progresses and future projects in the ELN EU-MDS registry project. The Trial Platform EMSCO and the planned trials within this project were discussed, as well as the progress of Triage-MDS. The results of the 7th ELN workshop of flow cytometry in MDS were reported. Progress of guidelines for allogeneic SCT in MDS was presented. The details of the HORIZON 2020 project MDS-RIGHT and the preceding kick-off meeting were explained to the auditorium.

Session II (15:15 – 17:15)

Inflammation in MPN

In a new working session, for the first time the role of inflammation in the pathogenesis of MPNs was addressed. There were presentations on inflammation-linked co-morbidities (the HEMADIMOR project), the ITCH deficiency and on cerebral blood flow in polycythemic murine models.

WP5 (acute myeloid leukemia (AML)) together with **WP10** (diagnostics) **and WP12** (MRD) had a roundtable discussion on MRD, dealing with the clinical background, technical demands and the integration of molecular and MFC-MRD in clinical studies.



Additionally, there were presentations on APL relapse data of the PROMYSE registry, new drugs for relapsing or refractory AML and the Bromodomain Inhibitor OTX-015.

WP6 (European working group for ALL (EWALL)) discussed the First results of the GIMEMA LAL 1509 Protocol for newly diagnosed Ph+ALL patients and of the study on frontline Nilotinib in elderly Ph+ALL patients. The follow-up of the so called “rotational” GIMEMA trials and the results of the NILG trial were presented.

WP9 (chronic myeloproliferative diseases, CMPD) discussed a proposal of an educational project in MPN. Three ELN projects on MPN (ELN ERNEST registry, inflammation and bone marrow morphology) and the update of the ELN pregnancy registry were presented. A study of the socio-economic effects of the participation in clinical trials highlighted a new aspect of potential impact for patients.

WP14 (stem cell transplantation) gave an overview on projects concerning the topic HCT vs CT randomized study in elderly patients with AML. The second allo manuscript was presented, as well as the Post-GvHD recommendation activities and the Post-GvHD recommendations. The reduced intensity conditioning regime before transplantation in MDS (RICMAC) study was compared to the conventional conditioning. An EBMT prospective study on allogeneic SCT in T-prolymphocytic leukemia (T-PLL) was introduced. There were presentations on the Myeloma NMAM statistical evaluation, Global transplant activities and an EBMT/ELN/ERIC proposal on recommendations for stem cell transplantation in T-PLL, which was discussed.

Session III (17:45 – 19:15)

WP10 (diagnostics), **WP11** (cytogenetics), **WP12** (minimal residual disease), and **WP13** (next generation sequencing) had a joint meeting and reported on cytomorphology, immunophenotyping, cytogenetics, MRD monitoring and the role of NGS in leukemia diagnostics. An integrated approach of these topics was discussed with all participants.

WP10 gave an update on the morphology faculty and the Harmonemia project. **WP11** (cytogenetics) had two presentations: on the European data on monosomy 7 in MDS, and on parameters that influence the technical performance in chromosome banding analysis. **WP13** (NGF) discussed an approach to an MDS data set and new cooperations in form of panels and platforms.

WP3 (CICS) elucidated the importance of simplified, harmonized and re-usable documentation of common data elements in leukemia trials and registries.

On the third day (**4.2.2014**), each workpackage summarized results in a plenary session (8:00 – 10:00).



The scientific symposium started with the presentations of five ELN Merit Awards to Prof. Francois-Xavier Mahon (Bordeaux), Dr. Nick Cross (Salisbury), Prof. Martin Müller (Mannheim), Prof. Tiziano Barbui (Bergamo), and Prof. Gert Ossenkoppele (Amsterdam).

Five keynote lectures followed with invited speakers from Europe, USA and China. L. Malcovati from Pavia, Italy, reported on recommendations from the ELN regarding diagnoses and treatment of primary myelodysplastic syndromes in adults. M. Horowitz from Milwaukee, USA, gave a lecture on stem cell transplantation 2015. J. Wang from Tianjin, China, gave an overview on the situation of adult leukemia in his country. M. Schrappe from Kiel, Germany, introduced diagnoses and treatment of childhood ALL and J. Spivak from Baltimore, USA, reported on two clinical phenotypes in polycythemia vera.

The ELN **General Assembly** approved fourteen new institutions, so that to date 218 institutions participate from 43 countries. There were three new countries (Saudi Arabia, Uzbekistan and Macedonia).

The eleventh information letter was prepared for the symposium in 2015, highlighting the current progress on projects and listing studies and upcoming meetings. It fosters cooperation amongst network members and informs the public on current topics in leukemia.

Assessment of results and impact of the Symposium on the future direction of the field

The 12th Annual Symposium highlighted upfront European research in leukemia, also reaching out to other continents like the US and Asia. Leukemia is a rare disease and European clinical trials are important to gain a broad patient collective, to discuss and compare results and offer optimal treatment for patients. European harmonisation efforts are of major importance for progress in leukemias worldwide. Important activities include consensus decisions in clinical study endpoints, the set up of patient registries for all leukemias, common standardisation procedures and classification systems in diagnosis and follow up (molecular monitoring, cytogenetics, minimal residual disease assessment), but also harmonisation in data evaluation and reporting. Cooperative research is the only way to cure leukemia.

The ELN offers innovative ideas and internationally recognized research. The ELN integrates a large portfolio of new disease markers, novel targets, drugs, drug-combinations and dose-optimisation



studies, vaccination approaches and next generation high-throughput technologies developed in a harmonised setting of European collaborations. All WPs and projects are the basis for high quality research, essential for European excellence in the field of leukemia research and cure of leukemia. This impacts patients, health care economics and society and results in faster implementation of best treatment options for all patients across Europe and beyond.

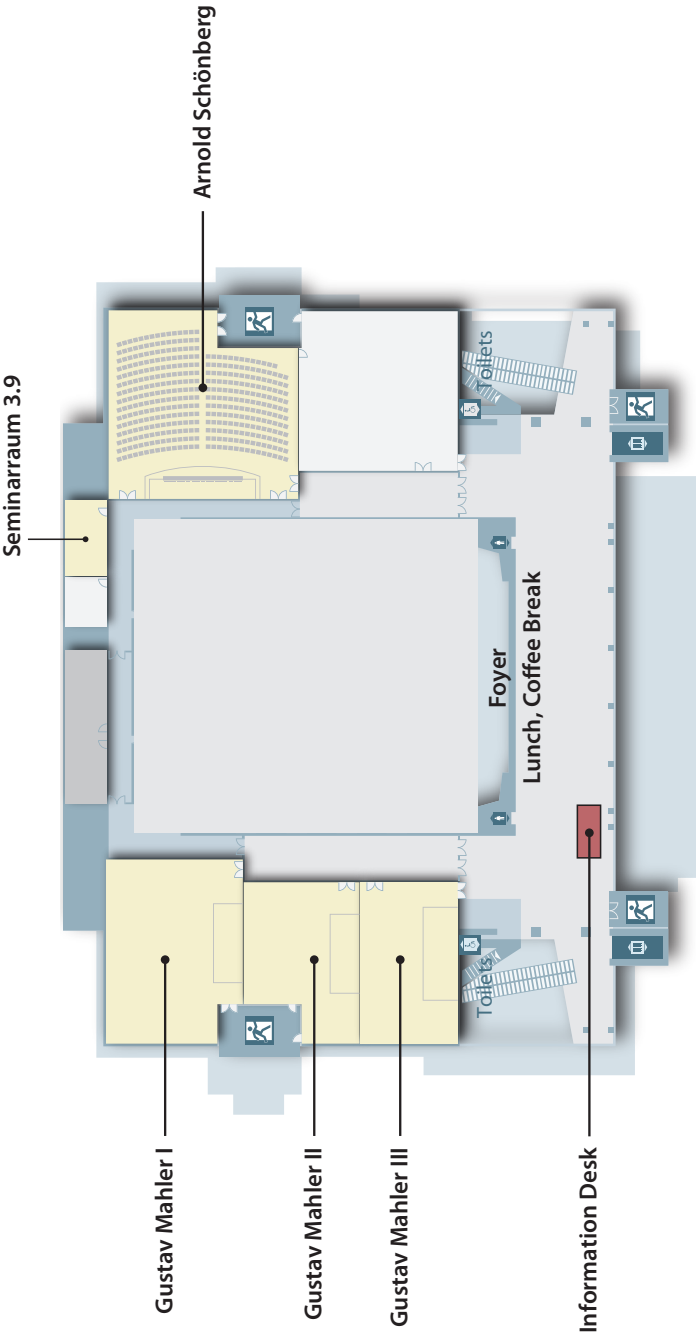

Topic 1: Welcome and overview ELN 2015 (R. Hehlmann)

R. Hehlmann gave a short overview on the 2014 achievements and future plans (s. attachment)

Topic 2: Approval of the SC Meeting Minutes (June 12, 2014, Milano)

The minutes were approved unanimously.

Topic 3: ELN Foundation and ELN Foundation Circle: Current status report

(1) ELN Foundation

An overview on the financial status was given (see attachment). In total, a sum around 18.000€ is available for project financing.

(2) ELN Foundation Circle.

The ELN Foundation circle comprises 8 pharma companies so far (see attachment). The sum of 75.000€ was attracted. The payment process is still ongoing in one case due to companies' internal proceedings. The NMC will continue to contact companies and also to attract higher funding sums.

Topic 4: EHA-SWG for CML in cooperation with ELN

B. Simonsson reported on the future cooperation of WP4 with EHA within an EHA-SWG. ELN-WP meeting will continue and an EHA-SWG for CML in cooperation with ELN starts in Vienna.

Topic 5: Educational activities

S. Saußele gave an overview on educational activities financed through the ESF but also through the cooperation with EUTOs for CML (see attachment).

Topic 6: ESF-ELN final report

The ESF project ends in May and a final report has to be prepared; deadline mid of August. The NMC will contact all WPs in due time with more information and ask for support in this matter. Regarding finances: NMC applied for the complete funding sum to finance this ELN meeting. An overview was given to all participants.

Topic 7: ELN-webpage

N. Gökbüget summarized the success and problems of the webpage. It was agreed also in view of limited budget resources to focus on a minimal content which should be as actual as possible. Again the support of WPs is appreciated and necessary.

Topic 8: New ELN sponsoring concept and structure

M. Müller was appointed Financial Network Manager (FNM). He discussed several options how to increase income to the ELN foundation by intensification of fund-raising activities, e.g. approach 'known donors' of the region, organize fund-raising events, e.g. charity dinners, broader focus on patient-centric activities and by encouraging companies to sponsor individual research projects / clinical trials with overhead for the ELN. The possibility of a membership fee was declined.

Topic 9: Horizon 2020: ELN-Participation in MDS-RIGHT

WP8 had successfully applied in the HORIZON 2020 program. ELN NMC and ELIC are incorporated as project partners.

Topic 10: Participation of ELN in WBMT

D. Niederwieser demonstrated the webpage of the WBMT where ELN is represented as project partner. He encouraged the SC members to cooperate with the WBMT.


