Scientific Report of 2nd visit through EURO-XPRAG travel grant no 3811

The objective of the second visit of Assimakopoulos to Tomlinson and Bott at Cardiff was to finalise and run the second experiment as well as discuss in more detail the results of the first one that will be presented at the forthcoming XPrag conference in Barcelona. Building on the dataset of the 1st experiment, we prepared a second list of natural data (see attached), comprising 76 triples of sentences (with a nonsensical, literal and a pragmatically enriched, narrower or metaphorical version). This time, however, we included a context sentence with a view to see whether this would facilitate the comprehension of the enriched expression, as Noveck et.al. (2001) have suggested. Also, instead of controlling for the final lexical item under question, we now controlled for the context, keeping it the same across the literal and figurative conditions for each item. We then ran the experiment counterbalancing the sentences between the participants. In this respect, much like in the previous experiment, half participants would be presented with half the enriched and half the figurative sentences and the other half would be presented with the rest, while in each group, half would be presented with the 'Sense' option on the left of the screen and the 'Nonsense' one on the right and vice versa. Additionally, we compiled a list of the figuratively used items with a view to ask the participants to evaluate them in terms of conventionality on a scale of 1 to 7. In this respect, we will be able to cross-check our results with the ones provided by Jones and Estes (2006), the paper from which we have borrowed our metaphor items. So far, we have already collected data from 12 participants and Tomlinson will continue to collect them in the following two weeks so that we incorporate some preliminary results in our poster for the XPrag conference. All in all, this visit should conclude the first part of the experiment, which aims at cross-checking the ways in which the computation of the literal meaning of a lexical item relates to the processing of a metaphorical or narrower interpretation of it in context, using the novel mousetracking paradigm. This will pave the way for the second part of our study that will focus even more closely on the on-line processing of lexical meaning adjustment, through the use of a more creative technique that will incorporate pictures in our task. The preparation for this, along with the drafting of a paper on the first experiment's results will be the main aims of the forthcoming third visit of Tomlinson to Assimakopoulos at the University of Granada.
