

Task Force “Science Questions”

Science Questions - Key Actions suggested (by the RESOLVE leaders)

- ✓ RESOLVE should build on the **ICSU visioning exercise** and the **Belmont Challenge** in the most useful way, without undertaking a major effort (which would not be feasible in the RESOLVE timeframe), and without compromising the **RESOLVE mission** expected from the RESOLVE initial stakeholders
- ✓ RESOLVE WGs and RESOLVE as a whole should include specific **recommendations** on how to best tackle the European **implementation** of the research activities associated to the ICSU Grand Challenges
- ✓ RESOLVE WGs should examine what could be the impact of those research activities, taking into account the **multi-culturalism** existing in Europe
- ✓ RESOLVE WGs should examine critically some specific ICSU questions to “**test**” and “**integrate**” them in their own work
