### **Objectives**

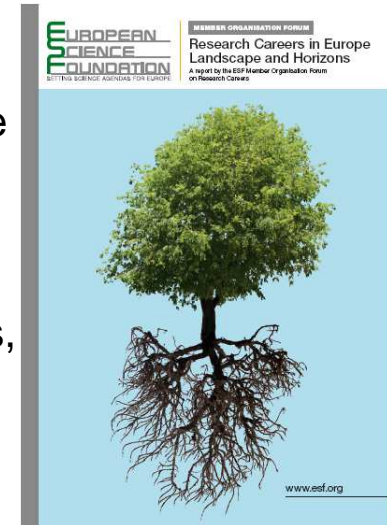
- Ensuring career and transferable skills development for researchers, including international or inter-sectoral mobility

- Providing equal playing fields for researchers of all backgrounds.

### **Participation**

19 organisations (+ 5 observers)

### **Actions / WGs**

- 1 – Taxonomy : validate existing taxonomies and to map career tracking surveys,
- 2 – Skills: build on the skills list of Vitae, explore the wider use of the Vitae Researcher Development Framework and develop guidance on provision of professional development opportunities.
- 3 – Mobility: policy recommendations for intersectoral mobility, good practice regarding scientific visa and peer review taking note of portfolio careers.
