Goal: agreed framework and joint tool for researchers' continuous professional development in Europe

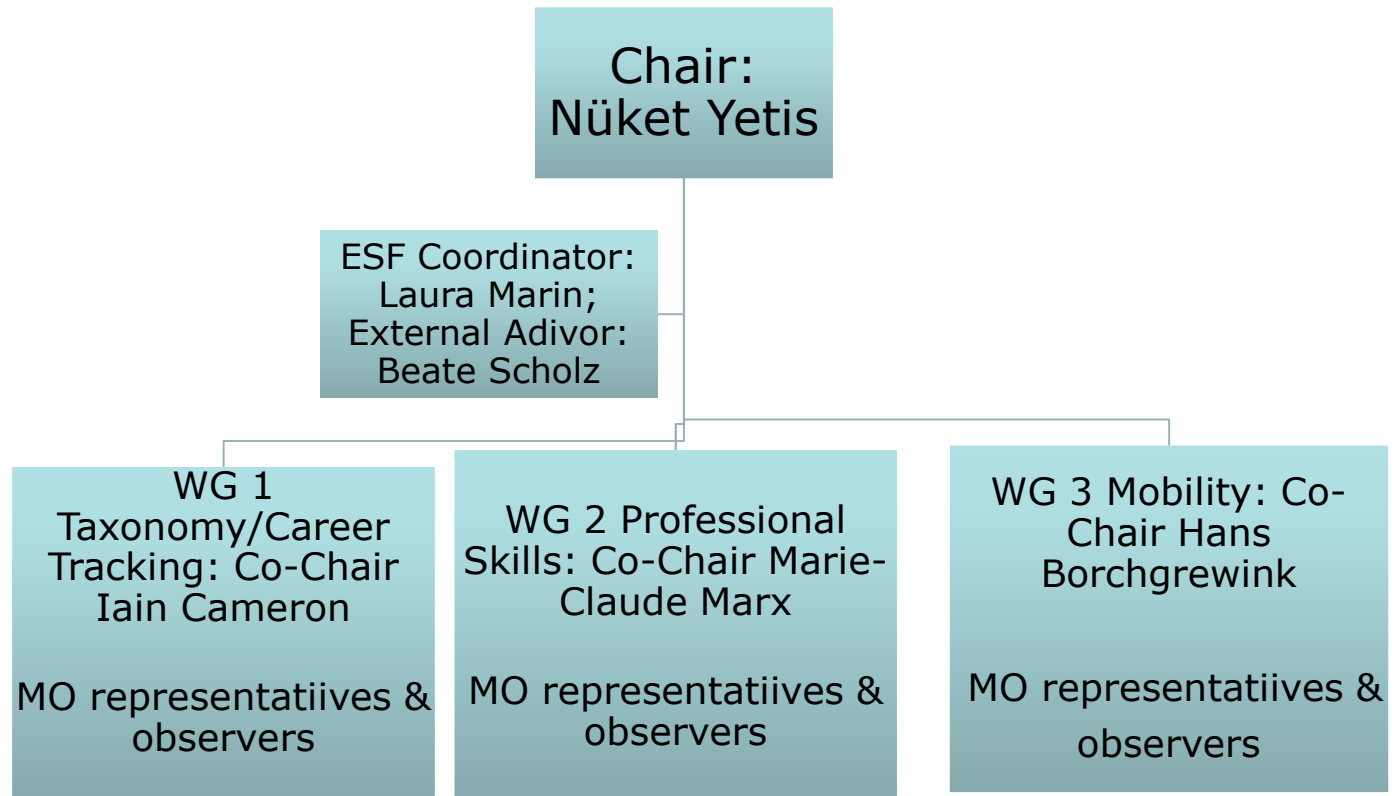
