Overall objective

Actions

- Assess the feasibility of a pan-European professional development framework for researchers
- Produce guidance for research organisations and funders on good practice in policy and practice in enhancing researcher skills
- Raise awareness of the importance of continuous professional development for researchers at all career stages

- 9. Evaluation/appraisal systems



Development of guidance

- From each C&C principle related to skills:
- deduce practical recommendations for research funders and research organisations
- Illustrate the recommendations with examples of good practice
- Further considerations:
- recommendations may be specific for researchers from distinct stages of the European careers structure
- Link to the skills list from the earlier MO Forum on reseach careers
- Collect recommendations from the researchers in the frame of the feasibility study
