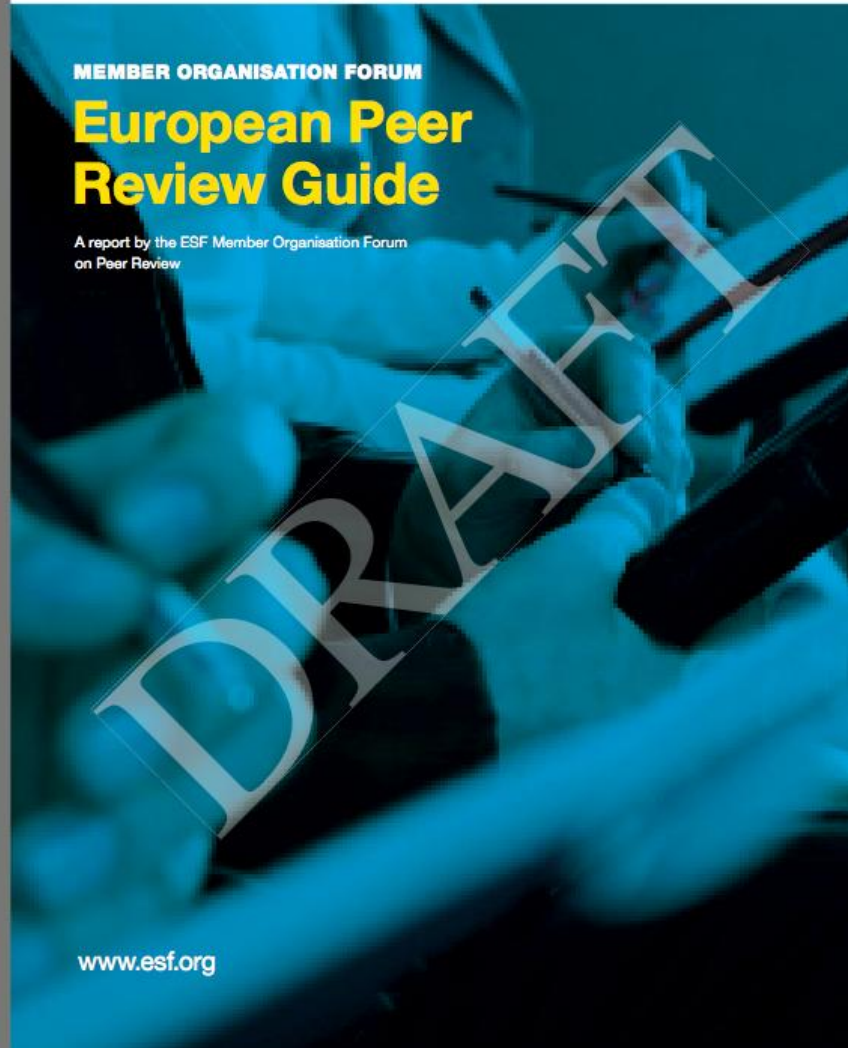

# ESF Survey Report: Executive Summary

**Rationale:** spirit and purpose of the survey + main highlights and general patterns.

## Outline:

- Introduction
- The Survey (structure, participation, programmes...)
- Highlights: research classification system; peer review procedures and steps; duration of the peer review procedures; database; college of reviewers; fatigue; incentives; MICT.

**Format:** 6-8 pages, text and figures, colour, print.
