



Special National Funding Agency eligibility and Requirements for participation in EUROCORES:

Please note that this list may not be complete since it is updated only as information becomes available to the ESF office from the participating EUROCORES Funding Agencies (EFAs). It remains your responsibility to check with your national funding agency for the most recent requirements. The contact persons for all participating organizations are provided on the last page of the Call for Proposal.



Czech Republic

Please be aware that in parallel to the EUROCORES application, the applicants from the Czech Republic have to submit a national proposal to the Czech Science Foundation.

France

Please note that the CNRS is only funding scientists from laboratories connected with CNRS. Also, you should be aware of CNRS' guidelines and restrictions for funding new research staff positions (Post-docs, PhDs) within the EUROCORES Programmes.

Germany (Max Planck Institutes)

The Max Planck Institutes are provided with funds to support their own international projects. If a Max Planck Institute takes part in a EUROCORES Programme which is not within the DFG funding scope, the institute has to cover the costs with its own budget. The Max-Planck-Society (MPS) circulated a letter to this effect to its MPIs. Applicants are requested to contact their MPI director and the EUROCORES contact person listed in the respective Calls for outline proposals for more details.



Italy

Please note that the CNR is normally funding scientists from CNR institutes, but not scientists from Universities or other research organisations. Requirements of CNR are provided here <http://soi.cnr.it/~urspci/urspci/ita/esf.htm#EUROCONFERENZE>



Poland

Please contact the Ministry of Research and Academy of Sciences because you will have to submit a national proposal to your funding institution.
