“What is nanomedicine?”

Professor Shervanthi Homer-Vanniasinkam is Consultant Vascular Surgeon at Leeds General Infirmary, Clinical Sub-Dean of Leeds University Medical School and Professor of Translational Vascular Medicine at the University of Bradford. She also holds a number of national and international professorships and chairs the NanoMedNet network for nanomedicine.



Professor Tony Turner is Distinguished Professor of Biotechnology and Professor of Biosensor Technology at Cranfield University, Editor-in-Chief of *Biosensors and Bioelectronics*, and author of more than 600 publications on biosensors. He is Director of Cranfield Diagnostics Ltd and Founding Inventor of Eximogen Ltd.



Richard Moore is Manager of Nanomedicine and Lifesciences at the Institute of Nanotechnology. He is an expert on risk management and previously worked for 10 years as Director of Science and Innovation at the European Medical Technology Association, EUCOMED
