

Report on the conference “Physics and developments in modern algebra

The conference was held on October 21–24, 2009 in Gothenburg. There were 48 participants and 23 of them gave talks, which were divided into 2 categories, 45 min talks given by senior researchers and 30 min talks given by junior researchers. The participants came from the following countries: Sweden, Denmark, Norway, Germany, France, England, USA, Spain, Swiss, China, Russia. They represented two scientific communities, physicists and mathematicians. Their main objectives of the conference: **to bring together these two communities for discussions, exchange of expertise, knowledge and methods** were successfully achieved.
